

1 SCOPE

This standard applies to all Husky team members, contractors, global suppliers and customers

2 DOCUMENT CONTROL

Revisions to this document shall be authorized by Environment, Health and Safety.

3 Banned Substances

In accordance with our commitment to team member health and safety and the environment, we ask that our team members, contractors, global suppliers and customers follow the guidelines below when choosing their product packaging.

The following is a list of Husky banned substances:

- Products containing any IARC Group 1, Group 2A or Group 2B carcinogens
- Chemicals containing mutagens
- Chemicals containing teratogens
- Chemicals containing skin sensitizers

In addition, these chemicals are specifically banned from all Husky locations:

- Acrylonitrile
- Arsenic
- Asbestos
- Benzene
- Coke oven emissions
- Ethylene oxide
- Isocvanates
- Lead
- Mercury
- Silica
- Toluene
- Trichloroethane
- Trichloroethylene
- Vinyl chloride
